Our Host Families

- o One nationality/native language per host family.
- o All meals included - breakfast and dinner with host families and a packed lunch for school and trips.
- o Many of our families come back year after year to host with us.

Our Classes

- o Excellent teacher to student ratio - average 12 students per class in 2026
- o CEFR-aligned curriculum specially designed for teenagers, constantly updated based on student/teacher feedback and latest research.

- o Passionate and enthusiastic teachers with experience teaching teens, and with teaching students with a range of learning differences (such as dyslexia, ADHD etc.).

Our Excursions

Students have at least two excursions each week, a midweek half-day excursion and a full-day excursion on Saturday.

Visit famous Irish attractions such as Glendalough National Park, Irish National Heritage Park, Dunbrody Famine Ship, Kilkenny City, Duncannon Fort, Dunmore Caves. And of course, Dublin City.

Students travel by private bus under the supervision and support of school staff throughout the excursion.

We aim to reach a balance between organised, guided, cultural experiences and student free time to explore the area safely. Our staff are always available nearby to provide assistance.

Through our feedback, we have learned that the excursions are often the highlight of the trip for a lot of our students. This gives them an insight into the culture and beauty of Ireland, along with some fond lifelong memories to cherish.
